The workshops will be presented by UAB Idiomes Barcelona teacher trainer Kieran Donaghy (<a href="http://kierandonaghy.com/">http://kierandonaghy.com/</a>) who is a renowned specialist in the use of film



and video in language education. **Kieran** has taught in the UK, Italy, Portugal and Spain and has taught at UAB Idiomes Barcelona, the language school of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona in Barcelona, for the last 16 years. He has extensive experience of teacher training and is a regular keynote and plenary speaker at conferences throughout the world. He has a special interest in the use of film in the classroom and writes extensively about film and education. Kieran is the co-author of *Films in Health Sciences Education* (Edicions de la Universitat de Barcelona) and *How to Write Activities for Film and Video* (ELT Teacher2Writer), and the author of the methodology book *Film in Action* (DELTA Publishing).

He is the founder of the website Film English (<a href="http://film-english.com/">http://film-english.com/</a>) which won a British Council ELTons Award for Innovation in Teacher Resources, the most prestigious award in English language teaching, the MEDEA Award, the most prestigious European media in education prize, in 2013, and an English Speaking Union Award in 2014. Kieran is also the founder of the only conference exclusively on the use of images in language teaching, The Image Conference (<a href="http://theimageconference.org/">http://theimageconference.org/</a>), and the co-founder of the Visual Arts Circle (<a href="https://visualartscircle.com/">https://visualartscircle.com/</a>), a community of practice made up of language teaching professionals, with a shared belief in the value of visual arts in language education. He holds a BA in Politics from the University of Nottingham, and Master's degrees in English Language Teaching from Rovira i Virgili University, and Business Communication from Pompeu Fabra University.
